

Selectmen Meeting Minutes  
Monday, March 21, 2011

Present: Chairman Bellville, Selectmen Ebbighausen, Darcy, Schill, & Smith and TA Collins.

Chairman Bellville called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Selectman Smith made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 14, 2011 meeting, second by Schill. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Smith made a motion to approve the Tax Collector Supplemental Warrant in the amount of \$5,699.04, second by Ebbighausen. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Smith made a motion to sign the MS-2 Report of Appropriations and Actually Voted, second by Ebbighausen. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Ebbighausen made a motion to have the Chairman sign the grant application to be submitted to USDA for the Ford Expedition voted on at Town Meeting for a request of \$13,300 in grant funds, second by Smith. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Schill made a motion to sign the manifest, second by Darcy. Motion passes 4 to 0. Ebbighausen abstained.

Discussion took place regarding the County Budget. Figures between the Commissioners proposed budget and the Delegate's proposed budget were discussed. The Commissioners budget would see approximately a 15.7% increase in the tax rate for the county versus the Delegates proposed budget of a 6.51% increase in the county tax rate.

6:18 p.m. Selectman Ebbighausen made a motion to adjourn the Selectmen's Meeting so the Selectmen could attend the County Budget Meeting to be held in Keene at 7:00 p.m., second by Schill. Motion passes unanimously.
