

SELECTMEN'S MINUTES

MONDAY, APRIL 18, 2011

Present: Chairman Bellville, Selectmen Schill, Darcy, Ebbighausen, T. A. Collins, Selectman Smith was excused.

6:00 p.m. Chairman Bellville opened the meeting.

Selectman Schill made a motion to sign the manifest, second by Selectman Ebbighausen, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Schill made a motion to accept the minutes of April 11<sup>th</sup>, second by Selectman Ebbighausen, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to approve the minutes of the non public session of April 11<sup>th</sup>, second by Selectman Ebbighausen, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Ebbighausen made a motion to approve the veteran exm. for Case #124, second by Selectman Schill, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Ebbighausen made a motion to abate Martin Bolduc taxes in the amount of \$271.78, second by Selectman Schill, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Ebbighausen made a motion to sign the Current Use application for Radouan Soumer, second by Selectman Schill, motion passed unanimously.

George Sansoucy met with the board this evening. He said after he does his update for Comcast he will come back with his recommendations.

He also recommended the board deny Trans Canada's abatement application.

George will also do the assessment on the new Wal-Mart property.

The board reviewed the Prentiss Taylor Memorial Field applications the following changes need to be made:

- 1) #4 move the word "NO" down one line so it reads "NO ALCOHOL PERMITTED WITHOUT PERMIT"
- 2) Page 2 - #2 to read "A key shall be issued to user.
- 3) Page 2 - #3 to read "Rake field"

The board will review the license agreement at next weeks meeting.

The following dept. heads were present: Frank Podlenski, Dennis Nadeau, Wayne Gallagher, & Robert Johnson. Also present were CIP comm. members: Keith Sanderson and Peter Zavorotny.

Chairman Bellville stated the board would like the dept.'s to keep logs of their maint. etc. Selectman Ebbighausen said that they need to keep up with inflation costs and would like to see them stagger the replacement of equipment.

Dennis said the CIP comm. already has a list of repairs that need to be made etc.

Each dept. head said they do keep logs for all their equipment etc.

Peter asked if they want an expendable trust for each piece of equipment or just one trust to cover everything.

Peter also asked if fire apparatus could be rebuilt rather than replaced. Bob said the three pieces just purchased can be refurbished, but would it be cost effective.

Bob recommended the board give the dept. heads forms stating the information they would like to have. The board agreed this is a good idea.

Dennis said the backhoe is fifteen years old but it is not a piece of junk, because they have taken care of it.

Frank gave the board an update on the Pond Rd. situation. Chairman Bellville said he went out to look at it and it had been cleaned up. Selectman Schill said the owner told him he did not sweep it into the road, his landscaper did it, he said the owner did admit it was wrong to do this. After further discussion the board agreed they should all visit the site and determine boundary lines etc.

Frank asked the board what they want for height on the new sidewalk on Brattleboro Rd. The board also mentioned they would like to have a mirror put on the pole .

Selectman Schill made a motion to appoint Lisa Bomba as an alternate on the conservation comm., second by Selectman Darcy, motion passed unanimously.

Chairman Bellville reported on the school board meeting he attended last week.

Selectman Schill noted that he found someone to do the trapping of beavers for Winifield Thomas.

He also noted that on the S Curve on Rt. 63 is a huge ditch and there are no guard rails, he feels the State should be contacted regarding this matter.

Chairman Bellville asked if a letter had been sent to Canal St. LLC, Jill will do this.
