

The Selectmen Meeting Minutes  
Monday, February 23, 2015

Present: Chairman Rideout; Selectmen Darcy; Gallagher; and TA Collins. Selectmen O'Malley and Smith excused.

6:00 p.m. Chairman Rideout called the meeting to order.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to approve the public and non-public minutes of February 16, 2015, second by Darcy. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to approve the manifests of February 17<sup>th</sup> and 23<sup>rd</sup>, second by Gallagher. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to approve the open container permit for the Fire Department Christmas Party to be held on December 12, 2015 at the Community Center, second by Darcy. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to sign the Certification of Yield Taxes Assessed for Map 7, Lot 4 property owned by Andrew Duggan in the amount of \$1,928.48, second by Gallagher. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Darcy made the motion to approve the Veteran's credit for application 022315-1, second by Gallagher. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to approve the final draft of the Town Clerk & Tax Collector Compensation Policy, second by Darcy. Motion passes unanimously.

6:08 p.m. Selectman Gallagher made a motion to enter into non-public session under RSA 91:A-3, II, (a) personnel, second by Darcy. The vote is as follows: Rideout – I; Darcy – I; Gallagher – I. Motion passes unanimously.

6:25 p.m. Regular meeting reconvened.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to seal the minutes, second by Gallagher. The vote is as follows: Rideout – I; Darcy – I; Gallagher – I. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Darcy requested a copy of the Highway Expenditure for the next meeting.

A boundary line adjustment was approved at the planning board meeting.

Gordon Schofield informed the board that Earth Day events will take place on April 18<sup>th</sup> with a rain date of April 25<sup>th</sup>. Discussion took place regarding bags being brought to the transfer station. The conservation commission would like to see a free day for disposing of mattresses; sofas; televisions; and other electronics. Hwy Supt. Frank Podlenski will be invited to a meeting to discuss this further.

April Anderson approached the board in regard to a Colorthon to be sponsored by the PTA. Discussion took place on the route of the marathon. Additional details will be provided to the board as plans are finalized. The Selectmen gave their consent to continue planning the race.

A representative from Oak Hill Acres was present to request the abatement of interest on a property the park is taking over (25 Gateway Drive) and the park will pay the outstanding taxes in the amount of \$2,481.11 which will bring the property current. Selectman Darcy made a motion to abate the interest, second by Gallagher. Motion passes unanimously.

The representative also requested to enter into a payment arrangement for water. He was directed to speak to the water/sewer collection clerk.
