

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes
Monday, February 29, 2016

Present: Chairman Darcy, Selectmen Gallagher; Nebelski; Rideout; and TA Collins. Selectman Diorio excused.

6:00 Chairman Darcy called the meeting to order.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to approve the manifest for February 29nd, second by Nebelski. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to approve the regular minutes and the non-public minutes of February 2, 2016, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

6:05 p.m. Selectman Rideout made a motion to enter into a non-public session under RSA 91:A-3, II, b. hiring, second by Nebelski. The vote is as follows: Darcy – I; Gallagher– I; Nebelski – I; Rideout – I. Motion passes unanimously.

6:10 p.m. Regular meeting reconvened.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to hire Emily Yelle for First Response Training at the Police Department, second by Nebelski. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to have Kyra Rideout work for a 3 week period as a clerk at the PD under the supervision of Chief Faulkner, second by Nebelski. The vote is as follows: Darcy – I; Gallagher– I; Nebelski – I; Rideout –abstained. Motion passes.

Tax Collector, James MacDonell presented an update on outstanding taxes.

Selectman Rideout made a motion to approve the First Amendment to November 29, 2010 Renewal Cable Television Franchise Agreement, second by Gallagher. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to approve the Open Container Permit for Jody Garland, Retirement Party, May 14, 2016, at Heritage Park, second by Nebelski. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to approve the Town Hall Facility Rental Request for the Hinsdale PTA Talent show. April 7th at 5:00 p.m. and April 10th at 10:00 a.m., second by Nebelski. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to approve the abatement for Bernard Warren (Freedom Acres), 4th quarter water bill in the amount of \$46.10 – supplemental bill has been issued, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to approve the abatement for Robert & Terry Butler, 30 Indian Acres, 3rd quarter water in the amount of \$29.04 and 3rd quarter sewer in the amount of \$43.43 and 4th quarter water in the amount of \$38.95 and 4th quarter sewer in the amount of \$58.51, second by Nebelski. Motion passes unanimously. Abatement submitted prior has been voided.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to have Jill Collins the authorized signature on Healthtrust Documents and to adopt the Certificate of Authorizing Resolution, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.
