

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes
Monday, March 7, 2016

Present: Chairman Darcy, Selectmen Diorio; Gallagher; Nebelski; Rideout; and TA Collins.
6:00 Chairman Darcy called the meeting to order.

Selectman Nebelski made a motion to approve the manifest for March 7, 2016, second by Rideout.
Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to approve the minutes and the non-public minutes of February 29, 2016, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.
