

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes
Monday, March 14, 2016

Present: Chairman Darcy, Selectmen Diorio; Gallagher; McCosker; Rideout; and TA Collins.

6:00 Chairman Darcy called the meeting to order.

Selectman Rideout made a motion to approve the minutes of March 7, 2016, second by Diorio. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Rideout made a motion to approve the manifest for March 14, 2016, second by Diorio. Motion passes unanimously.

Dodie Bevis was present. She wanted to apologize to Wayne Gallagher regarding her question about conflict of interest at town meeting. She was not trying to insinuate that Selectman Gallagher could not be trusted.

Appointments:

Selectman Rideout made a motion to appoint Selectman Gallagher as Chairman, second by Diorio. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Rideout made a motion to appoint Selectman Diorio as Vice-Chairman, second by Darcy. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Darcy will serve on the Planning Committee and Library Trustees as the Selectmen Representative.

Selectman Diorio will serve on the Budget Committee and School Board as the Selectmen Representative.

Selectman Gallagher will serve on the Conservation Commission and Cemetery Trustees as the Selectmen Representative.

Selectman McCosker will serve on the Capital Improvement Committee and the TIF Advisory Committee as the Selectmen Representative.

Selectman Rideout will serve on the Bridge Committee and the Community Center/Recreation Committee as the Selectmen Representative.

The Selectmen reviewed the contact information. Selectman McCosker gave his contact information to the board.

The Selectmen Guidelines and Procedures were passed out for all to review.

TA Collins discussed the Selectmen's email site. She will be sending email as usual and copying the email to the site for the Selectmen to log into to review. Eventually everything will be sent to the email address for all Selectmen to review. TA Collins and Selectman Darcy are looking at tablets for the Selectmen.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to approve the permit for retail sales of permissible fireworks for Fantasy Fireworks, second by Diorio. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to approve the notice of intent to cut for Richard Hood – Map 39, Lots 1, 2, & 3 – Chesterfield Rd, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Diorio made a motion to approve the 2015 1st quarter sewer abatement for Chance Whidby, 21 Old Stage Rd, in the amount of \$177.44 plus interest, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Diorio made a motion to approve the job works abatement for Robert Palmatier, 15 Mohawk St., in the amount of \$50.00, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Diorio made a motion to approve the sewer job works for Han Quinn, 22 Hancock St., in the amount of \$25.00, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Elementary School Principal Joe Boggio gave a proposal to the Selectmen regarding creating an outdoor obstacle course for the elementary school. The location would be between the ballfields. A shed will be needed for storage. Mr. Boggio will contact Frank Podlenski to look at the field space and field building for possible storage.

James O'Malley discussed the Post Office celebration which takes place August 4, 2016. The school is discussing the possibility of a time capsule.

James O'Malley will start coming the Monday meeting before school board, since Steve Diorio will be at the School Board meeting, he can report to the Selectmen the Monday after.

It was mentioned the Hinsdale Coalition link is still on the website and should be deleted.

Tax Collector, James MacDonell will be bringing in the deed list for the Selectmen to review. He indicated that the Town should consider giving an easement to DOT for the drainage. Selectman Darcy made a motion to send a letter to DOT to see if they would like an easement, second by McCosker. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Rideout mentioned he was happy with town meeting. Rideout asked if we have received the Performa. TA Collins sent an email as a reminder but has not received a response from George Sansoucy.

Selectman Darcy has a planning board meeting and a library trustee meeting coming up.

6:50 p.m. Selectman Darcy made a motion to adjourn, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.
