

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes
Monday, April 18, 2016

Present: Chairman Gallagher, Selectmen Darcy; Diorio; McCosker; Rideout; and TA Collins.

6:00 Chairman Gallagher called the meeting to order.

Selectman Diorio made a motion to approve the manifest of April 18, 2016, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Diorio made a motion to approve the minutes of April 11th with correction of the spelling of Mollie Kaylor's name; minutes of April 12th; non-public minutes of April 11th; and the public hearing minutes of April 11th, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to approve the Warrant to Collect Excavation Taxes from Wayne Corse in the amount of \$409.42, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.
