

The Selectmen Meeting Minutes
Monday, April 20, 2015

Present: Chairman Darcy; Selectmen Diorio; Gallagher; Nebelski; Rideout and TA Collins.

6:00 p.m. Chairman Darcy called the meeting to order.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to approve the manifests of April 13, 2015, second by Nebelski. Motion passes unanimously.
