

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes
Monday, April 25, 2016

Present: Chairman Gallagher, Selectmen Darcy, Diorio, McCosker and Rideout.

6:00 Chairman Gallagher called the meeting to order at the Meetinghouse (Boy Scout Hall).

Selectmen viewed the outside of the Meetinghouse property. Discussion included attention needed to missing slates on the roof, touch-up paint, lamp over door (motion detector light), front and back entry including stairs and ramp.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to table the minutes of 4/18/16 and manifests for 4/25/16, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectmen viewed the North Hinsdale Well property. Discussion reflected that not much had changed since the visit when the fence was installed.

Selectmen viewed condition of Oak Lawn Cemetery. Chairman Gallagher will check on the possibility of any available funds at next Cemetery Trustees Meeting.

Selectmen viewed the Bob Harcke property on Monument Road. Board discussed a possible drainage easement for area.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to have Highway Superintendent, Frank Podlenski start the process of setting up drainage easement and frontal easement for Bob Harcke land, second by McCosker. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectmen viewed Prentiss Taylor Field property. Discussion followed as to fencing needed and the condition of the covered picnic area.

Selectman McCosker made a motion to price two 25' length x 6' high sections of fencing to go in front of bench areas, second by Darcy. Motion passes unanimously.

7:10 p.m. Selectman Darcy made a motion to adjourn, second by McCosker. Motion passes unanimously.
