

The Selectmen Meeting Minutes
Monday, June 1, 2015

Present: Chairman Darcy; Selectmen Diorio; Gallagher; Nebelski; Rideout and TA Collins.

6:00 p.m. Chairman Darcy called the meeting to order.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to approve the public and non-public minutes of May 18, 2015, second by Nebelski. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to approve the manifest of May 25 & June 1, 2015, second by Nebelski. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to approve the CDBG Manifest dated June 1, 2015, second by Nebelski. Motion passes unanimously.

The Selectmen signed the appointment papers for Louis Yells.

The Selectmen received copies of the Temporary Water Meter Agreement sent via email. After a few grammar corrections there were no further comments.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to approve the 2015-2016 Salary Schedule, second by Diorio. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Rideout made a motion to approve lease paperwork for the Loader, second by Gallagher. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to approve the open container permit for Benjamin Rebaudo for June 6, 2015 at the Pavilion, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Nebelski made a motion to approve Water Abatement 1st quarter for James L. Plante, 53 Indian Acres, in the amount of \$208.28, second by Gallagher. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Nebelski made a motion to approve Water Abatement 1st quarter for Walmart in the amount of \$26,912.03, second by Gallagher. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Nebelski made a motion to approve Water Abatement 1st quarter for Cheshire Oil in the amount of \$24,135.59, second by Gallagher. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Nebelski made a motion to enter into a contract with Roberts & Greene for auditing services for the 1st year with the option of the remaining years, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

TA Collins informed the Board that the pool will be offering a Get Fit Friday day to town employees between the hours of 9 – 11 am.

Mike Darcy will be on vacation the 1st week of August and Bernie Rideout will be on vacation the last week of July and the second week of August.

Selectman Nebelski made a motion to hire Myia Boyd and Lauren Southwick as substitute counselors and snack bar attendants and Katelyn Towle as a counselor, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Peter Zavorotny, Budget Committee Chairman, joined the Selectmen to discuss the approach for the next budget season. Items discussed were joint meetings with the Selectmen and Budget Committee with Department Heads present. The committee will be meeting on August 19th and they are hoping to have the end of year budgets to review.

Selectman Rideout made motion to collect the full year taxes on manufactured home April 1st assessment prior to issuing a move permit, second by Nebelski. Motion passes unanimously.

Recreation Meeting discussion was for the billing of the lawn games for the Lawn Party; bills in general for the Lawn Party; and the Seasonal Program Director.

Selectman Diorio stated we should have electricity available at the sports field and the minutes need to be updated on the website. An informal discussion regarding the Solar Project took place.

Selectman Nebelski stated the lights for the flag poles should be placed in next year's budget. The LED needs to be replaced at Heritage Park. Highway Department should be wearing safety vests. There is a concern on the upkeep of the Cemeteries with stones hitting markers.

Selectman Gallagher mention the Teen Center committee met and they are working on the rules for the Teen Center. They have a list of eight chaperones to call and Leo Marshall is going to continue to be the advisor.

An update on the Field House was given – the ceiling has been removed, smoke detectors installed and the Building Inspector will be issuing an occupancy permit.

The Selectmen discussed a power purchase agreement with Solar Garden.
