

Selectmen Meeting
Monday, June 27, 2016

Present: Chairman Gallagher; Selectmen Darcy; McCosker; Rideout; and TA Collins. Selectman Diorio was excused.

6:00 p.m. Chairman Gallagher called to order.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to approve the manifests of June 20, 2016 and June 27, 2016, second by McCosker. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectmen Darcy made a motion to approve the public and non-public minutes of June 20, 2016, second by McCosker. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to have the chairman sign the Letter of Intent to apply for TAP funding for the sidewalks along Brattleboro Rd., second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to enter into a contract for services with SW Regional Planning Commission Municipal Technical Assistance Program in the amount of \$6,920, second by McCosker. Motion passes unanimously.

TA Collins passed out a Salary Schedule with merit increase – used annual salary for all employees 20 hours or more. Across the bottom you can see total budget increase base on .25; .5; etc. Of course this will stagger depending on review and meeting with department heads;

Selectman Darcy made a motion to approve the lease agreement for Ford F550 to be used by the Highway Department, second by McCosker. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to tentatively approve the vendor permit for Richard Willette at Phantom Fireworks pending all approval conditions have been met, second by McCosker. Motion passes unanimously.

Dominick Amaru was present to discuss the extension for the Oak Hill Acres park permit. He was informed the item will be addressed next week at their regular schedule meeting of July 11th.

Selectman Rideout asked if TA Collins has been in touch with the transit service regarding running a route from the Post Office to the Historical Society on August 4th for the celebration.

Selectman Rideout stated that banner project is doing well.

Selectman McCosker would like to see the threshold removed from the field building – it could be a possible trip hazard. He would also like to see the grass mowed on the side of the field building. He discussed the grubs and irrigating the field.

Selectman Darcy questioned the minivan that has been abandoned in the town parking lot – he would like to see it removed.

Selectman Darcy asked for an updated on the website. TA Collins is working with Avenet.
