

Selectmen Meeting Minutes
Monday, July 27, 2015

Present: Chairman Darcy, Selectmen Diorio, Nebelski, Rideout, and Gallagher.

6:00 p.m. Chairman Darcy called the meeting to order.

Selectman Rideout made a motion to approve the public hearing minutes of July 13th, second by Nebelski. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Nebelski made a motion to approve the manifest of July 20th, second by Rideout. Selectman Nebelski asked that we review the manifest of July 27th after the non-public session. Motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Darcy asked the board if they had a problem using money from the Downtown CDBG Funds to purchase hats and other items. The board would like to know how much money is available in the fund and then discuss ways to best promote Downtown Hinsdale.
