

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

Present: Chairman Gallagher, Selectmen Darcy, Diorio, McCosker; Rideout; and TA Collins.

6:00 Chairman Gallagher called the meeting to order.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to approve the manifests dated September 26th, second by McCosker. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to approve the minutes of September 19th, second by McCosker. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Diorio made a motion to approve the non-public minutes of September 19th, second by Darcy. Motion passes unanimously.
