

Selectmen Meeting Minutes  
Wednesday, November 18, 2015

Present: Chairman Darcy; Selectmen Diorio; Gallagher; Nebelski; Rideout and TA Collins.

6:32 p.m. Chairman Darcy called the meeting to order.

Budget Committee Members Present: Dori Almann; Bruce Bellville; Mike Carrier; Morris Klein; Lewis Major; James MacDonell; and Peter Zavorotny.

Fire Chief Matuszewski and Captain Roy were present to discuss the Fire Department Budget. Discussion took place regarding salaries; EMT training; and Vehicle Maintenance. The Fire Chief; Police Chief; and Cliff Hastings will be invited to the Selectmen's meeting of November 30<sup>th</sup> to discuss EMT training and certification process. Selectman Diorio made a motion to table the Fire Dept. Budget, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Rescue - Selectman Diorio made a motion to tentatively approve the Rescue Budget in the amount of \$135,558, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Peter Zavorotny asked about the soccer field. Selectman Darcy explained we received a bid of \$12,000 that needed to be acted on. Since we received a holiday contribution from Primex for our Workman's Comp in the amount of \$32,000 of which is a credit on this current year budget, there are monies available to take care of the field.
