Mr. Zavorotny called the meeting to order at 6:35 pm in the Town Hall.

Mr. Major moved and Mr. Bellville seconded to approve the minutes for meeting 612.

The motion passed unanimously.

Mr. Zavorotny noted that the Selectmen have scheduled two required Public Hearings relative to the Police Station project for Monday, November 26 and Monday, December 10. Both at 6:30 in the Town Hall. Members are encouraged to attend.

Budgets approved by the Selectmen were distributed. Mr. Rideout commented that the Selectmen had approved additional departments and had only a few to go. He also noted that budget proposals to date have looked good with few controversial items.

After some discussion, the committee decided to postpone action on the submitted budgets until we have had an opportunity to look them over. To that end a meeting was scheduled for Wednesday, December 5 at 6:30 in the Town Hall. Mr. Zavorotny will request updated requests for review next week so the Committee can look at all approved by the Selectmen at the December 5 meeting.

Mr. Rideout noted that Water and Wastewater rates are being reviewed to determine if they need to be adjusted. This will depend upon income vs. expenses and they are awaiting a report from the Treasurer.

Ms. McCosker noted that the School Board is on schedule for a final proposal in January. To this point the proposals have looked conservative. Dr. Crisafulli is reviewing a few items before passing along for Board review.

The next meeting was scheduled for December 5, 2012 at 6:30 in the Town Hall.

The meeting adjourned at 6:52pm on a motion by Mr. Bellville and second by Mr. MacDonell.
