

MINUTES OF THE SELECTMEN'S MEETING

MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 26, 2011

Present: Chairman Bellville, Selectmen Schill & Darcy, T. A. Collins, Selectmen Smith & Ebbighausen were excused.

6:00 p.m. Chairman Bellville opened the meeting.

Selectman Schill made a motion to sign the manifest, second by Selectman Darcy, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Schill made a motion to approve the minutes of the Sept. 19<sup>th</sup> meeting, second by Selectman Darcy, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Schill made a motion to approve the minutes of the non public meeting, second by Selectman Darcy, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Schill made a motion to approve the open container application for Sheena Bushee for Oct. 29<sup>th</sup> at the HCC, second by Selectman Darcy, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Schill made a motion to approve the open container permit application for Jeremy Kendrick for Oct. 8<sup>th</sup>, at the HCC, second by Selectman Darcy, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to sign the yield tax warrant for Shannon O'Connor in the amount of \$2,369.76, second by Selectman Schill, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to abate the following for Northern NE Telephone: \$4,908.18, \$6208.84, \$7,247.86, \$10,945.94, \$12,345.21, \$17,870.71, second by Selectman Schill, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Schill made a motion to allow the Hinsdale Town Band use of the upstairs hall for a concert on Oct9th, second by Selectman Darcy motion passed unanimously.

Comm. Dev. Co-Coordinator Kathryn Lynch, Representatives from TNT Fireworks, Fantasy Fireworks, & Phantom Fireworks. Chairman Bellville explained the reason they were asked to attend this evenings meeting is due to the fact that there have been a lot of code enforcement violations, he listed the following:

- 1) Temp. Signage
- 2) Blow up Signage (this has been taken care of)
- 3) Sign Graphic (this has been taken care of)
- 4) Board feels it is unsafe to have someone standing on the side of the road for advertising purposes.

The board explained that they will be petitioning the State to lower the speed limit along Rt. 119 from 50 MPH to 40 MPH for safety reasons.

They also informed everyone that the town is working on changes to the signage ordinance.

They also informed them that if they are in violation of the town ordinances they will pull their permits and they will be fined.

They explained that the permits for storage pods will be for a two year period and all three companies will be on the same two year schedule.

Selectman Darcy stated that the State may be passing a law banning temp. Storage units.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to allow the one year extension for Trist ate Firearms, LLC grant, second by Selectman Schill, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to accept the attached fee schedule, second by Selectman Schill, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Darcy reported on the following from the planning board meeting.

Canal St. LLC would like to put in an auction house to sell used vehicles.

Library meeting:

Asked to have the custodian clean the light covers in the building.

Said Library Trustee Karen Johnson would like to volunteer her services to clean the library. Jill said this cannot be done since she does the same type of work at the HCC and does receive payment for that position.

Selectman Schill reported on the workshop he attended along with Jill & Donna, he said it was very informational.

Chairman Bellville said he is still receiving complaints regarding the fact the assessor wishes to go into people's homes. Selectman Schill said he called the DRA regarding this matter and they said the person does not have to let them go into the home.

Angela Schill informed the board that she is the school board representative to the regional career center. She said Brattleboro is looking into adding various programs. The tuition cost would be going up.

It was suggested that the selectmen, school board and budget comm. have a joint meeting.

Jill will write a letter to the D.O.T. regarding the speed limit along Rt. 119.
