

MINUTES OF THE SELECTMEN'S MEETING

MONDAY, FEBRUARY 7, 2011

Present: Selectmen Bellville, Schill, Smith, T. A. Collins, Chairman Ebbighausen & Selectman Stephens were excused.

6:00 p.m. Selectman Smith opened the meeting.

Selectman Schill made a motion to sign the manifest, second by Selectman Bellville, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Bellville noted that the minutes of the Jan. 31st meeting did not mention the fact that he had asked about staff meeting minutes from the previous two meetings.

With the above noted Selectman Schill made a motion to approve the minutes as amended, second by Selectman Bellville, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Bellville made a motion to approve the water abatement for Beverly Bernier, second by Selectman Schill, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Bellville made a motion that the letter received from Morris Klein expressing his appreciation for the fast and courteous assistance he received from Officer Michael Bomba in his time of need, be placed in Officer Bomba's personnel folder, second by Selectman Schill, motion passed unanimously.

Jill explained in order to be eligible for a veteran's exemption the person has to be on the deed.

Selectman Schill stated he would like to see Vision Appraisal lower the assessment for the town by 25%. It was also recommended they be informed the town will be looking into other appraisal firms.

Selectman Bellville said he had spoken with Rep. William Butynski and he feels there should be a selectman representative on the Hinsdale Comm. Coalition Comm. Selectman Smith made a motion a letter be written to them asking them if they would like a representative from the board of selectmen, second by Selectman Schill, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Bellville would like the board to work on a survey to pass out at town meeting asking for town's opinion regarding location, etc. for a new police station.

Selectman Schill asked Jill if she wished to go over her goals for the coming year, she said she would like to wait until next week.

Selectman Smith noted that there is still ice built up on the HCC roof. Jill said that Karen had called Craig Finnell to take care of this.

Angela Schill said the Coakley's said they wanted a complaint form to complete but the form is not on the town web site. Jill will check into this.

She will also talk with Frank regarding the Coakley's complaint regarding snow plowing.

Selectman Bellville noted that the gates by the well site have been left opened the past few days.
