

TOWN OF HINSDALE YARD SALE ORDINANCE

This ordinance is enacted for the control of yard sales, and the traffic congestion they may create in a neighborhood, and for the aesthetic considerations of neighborhoods. Enforcement of this ordinance shall be by the Hinsdale Police Department.

Definitions:

- Dwelling: A building, or part of a building, which contains living and sleeping accommodations for permanent occupancy.
- Signage: In accordance with the Hinsdale Zoning Ordinance, Special Regulations, Signs, "temporary", shall not exceed three (3) square feet in size.
- Yard sale: The temporary sale of items, which is held on the site of any property within the Town of Hinsdale. This definition shall include, but not be limited to, garage sale, tag sale, moving sale, neighborhood sale, or any other name given to the sale by the operator(s).
- Year: January 1 through December 31.

The intent of this ordinance is to limit the number of yard sales someone may have during a year. Each dwelling shall be limited to four (4) yard sales a year.

In the case of a neighborhood sale, each dwelling involved in the neighborhood sale shall be counted as having a yard sale.

All signage for the sale shall include the street address, date of sale, rain date, and time of the sale. All signage, on site and off site, can be posted the day before the sale, but shall be removed at the end of the same day the sale is held. Failure to remove signage on a timely basis shall result in a fine of \$10.00.
