

TOWN OF HINSDALE  
STREET NUMBERING ORDINANCE

Public Hearing:

I PURPOSE

- A. To establish a system for assigning and/or altering address numbers of buildings and other property along any public or private way within the Town in accordance with RSA 231:133-a.
- B. To provide an efficient, expedient means of locating properties for emergency response teams.
- C. To establish the property location for mailing address purpose and utility connection services.

II NUMBERING SYSTEM

- A. The starting point for numbering will be the end of each street that is nearest Route 119, Route 63 and portions of Plain Road.
- B. Even numbers will be on the right side of the street.
- C. Odd numbers will be on the left side of the street.
- D. Intervals of fifty feet (50') along the frontage will be used to assign numbers.
- E. Each property owner will be responsible for displaying the assigned street number on their building so as to be clearly visible from the street. If the building is more than 200 feet from the curb of the road or not visible from the street, the property owner must also display the assigned street number at the driveway entrance. Each number shall be at least three (3) inches high and a contrasting color to the background.
- F. Each property owner must properly affix the given street number within two (2) months of official notification of the correct street address.
- G. In some instances, such as multi-unit buildings, it may be necessary to assign one street number to the building and assign unit numbers to each other unit. This numbering system will be at the discretion of the Hinsdale Board of Selectmen.

- H. It shall be the responsibility of the property owner who has a private road servicing two or more dwellings to place a sign at the entrance to the private road indicating the name of the private road. In some cases, where it is unclear as to the owner of the private road, the Town will take the responsibility of placing the road name sign.

III ENFORCEMENT

- A. The Hinsdale Street Numbering Ordinance is enforceable by the Hinsdale Board of Selectmen. Penalty for failure to timely affix or permanently affix the given street number or road sign shall be \$25.00. Such fine will be levied only after a written notice is sent to the property owner informing him of his failure to comply with this ordinance. The street numbering ordinance may be amended by the Hinsdale Board of Selectmen as deemed necessary after a public hearing on the proposed amendment is held.
