

Present: Chairman Ebbighausen, Selectmen Bellville, Schill, Smith & T. A. Collins.

6:00 p.m. Chairman Ebbighausen opened the meeting.

Selectman Schill made a motion to sign the manifest, second by Selectman Smith, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Schill made a motion to approve the minutes of the Feb. 7<sup>th</sup> meeting, second by Selectman Smith, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Smith made a motion to approve the elderly exemption for Case #61, second by Selectman Schill, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Smith made a motion to sign the abatement for Ash Swamp Brook in the amount of \$1,010.14, second by Selectman Bellville, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Smith made a motion to approve the open container application for Lori Johnson to be used at Heritage Park on July 9<sup>th</sup>, second by Selectman Schill, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Bellville made a motion to appoint Doriann Almann to the planning board to replace Kenneth Lee until the March elections, second by Selectman Smith, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Schill made a motion to sign the mutual aid agreement between the Sheriff's Dept. and the police dept., second by Selectman Smith, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Smith made a motion to sign the financial letter from auditors Vachon & Clukay, second by Selectman Bellville, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Smith made a motion to extend to April 14, 2011 the License to Sell Pistols & Revolvers for Tri State Fire Arms, second by Selectman Schill, motion passed unanimously.

6:30 p.m. Chairman Ebbighausen opened the public hearing.

6:35 p.m. Board resumed their regular meeting.

Selectman Schill noted that he was disappointed with the poor turn out for the public hearing. He also noted that at last year's town meeting it took only three people to make a difference in the vote to go to change the tax billing to quarterly.

Selectman Smith made a motion to accept the funds for Feed the Thousands and open a separate account for this, second by Selectman Schill, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Smith made a motion to send a letter to the County Commissioners and State Representatives regarding their concerns over the county commissioner's budget and the increase for

2011, second by Selectman Schill, motion passed unanimously. A copy of the letter will be sent to the Chesterfield select board.

Jill informed the board that the Hinsdale Coalition Comm. would like a selectman representative on the board. One will be appointed after the March election.

Jill explained to the board that she had talked with Highway Supt. Podlenski regarding the complaint of Mr. Coakley on Pond Rd. She said Frank said the town owns a 20' right of way, and most of the snow is going on the property of Norman Whittle Sr.. Selectman Bellville recommended the board look into this matter in the Spring.

It was also noted that Mr. Coakley said the Maple St/Fox Run road sign have been removed.

The board discussed possible location for a new police station. They feel the downtown would be the best place for it. They also would like to see it put on town owned property. A survey will be ready to hand out on election day and at town meeting.

Selectman Schill noted that he will be attending a meeting tomorrow morning along with Jill to meet with prospective company wishing to come into town.

Selectman Bellville said he understood Water Supt. Nadeau had received two bids for a backhoe, he would like to know what they are. Jill explained that this is not on the warrant for this year. He also said he would like Dennis to get figures with a trade in etc.
