

Selectmen Meeting

Monday, February 13, 2017

Present: Chairman Gallagher; Selectmen Darcy, Diorio, McCosker, Rideout, and TA Collins.

Meeting called to order at 6:00.

Selectman Diorio made a motion to approve the manifest of February 13, 2017, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Diorio made a motion to approve the minutes of February 6<sup>th</sup> & 8<sup>th</sup>, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

The following open container permits were presented for review:

1. Open container permit for the Fire Station for February 24<sup>th</sup>, from 6:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. after regular meeting. Discussion took place and more information was requested. Selectman Rideout made a motion to table the open container permit until the next meeting second by Diorio. Motion passes unanimously.
2. Open container permit for the Fire Department for August 26<sup>th</sup> from 11:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. at the Pavilion for FD Family Picnic. Selectman Darcy made a motion to approve, second by McCosker. Motion passes unanimously.
3. Open container permit for the Fire Department for September 29<sup>th</sup> from 6:00 p.m. to 10:00 p.m. at the Fire Station for Ladies Night. Selectman McCosker made a motion to approve, second by Diorio. Vote as follows: Darcy – No; Diorio – I; Gallagher – I; McCosker – I; Rideout – No. Motion passes 3 – 2.
4. Open container permit for the Fire Department for December 9<sup>th</sup> through the 10<sup>th</sup> from 6:00 p.m. to 2:00 am. At the community center for FD Christmas Party. Selectman Darcy made a motion to approve, second by McCosker. Motion passes unanimously.

The Selectmen reviewed an abatement request for George's Field Realty Trust for tax levy 2015 for the following properties:

- a. 7 George's Field in the amount of \$1,963.02;
- b. 11 George's Field in the amount of \$5,574.74;
- c. 18 George's Field in the amount of \$18,450.70;

Total abatement \$26,988.47 to be applied to 2016 taxes. Selectmen McCosker made a motion to deny the abatement, second by Diorio. Motion passes unanimously.

The Selectmen reviewed an abatement request for George's Field Realty Trust George's Field Realty Trust for tax levy 2016 for the following properties:

- d. 7 George's Field in the amount of \$3,037.70;
- e. 11 George's Field in the amount of \$5,695.70;
- f. 18 George's Field in the amount of \$18,851.00;

Total abatement \$27,584.40. Selectman Darcy made a motion to deny the abatement, second by McCosker. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to approve the sewer abatement for Dawn M. Santor Robinson in the amount of \$200.70 for the 3<sup>rd</sup> qtr. sewer and \$264.92 for the 4<sup>th</sup> qtr. sewer of 2016, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

The Selectmen reviewed and discussed the following policies:

1. Weather Related Closings. The Selectmen would like to remove the last bullet and add language regarding if an employee chooses to not report to work and the town facilities close, the employee will not be paid as if they reported to work.
2. Damage Mailboxes. TA Collins will schedule a public hearing.
