

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes
Monday, February 22, 2016

Present: Chairman Darcy, Selectmen Diorio; Nebelski; Rideout; and TA Collins. Selectman Gallagher excused.

6:00 Chairman Darcy called the meeting to order.

Selectman Diorio made a motion to approve the manifest for February 22nd, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Diorio made a motion to approve the minutes of February 17th and the non-public minutes of January 25th and February 17th, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Nebelski made a motion to approve the CDBG Manifest for the payments of \$31,000 to Zaluzny and \$12,650 to Oak Hill Acres for the Oak Hill Acre Infrastructure Project, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Nebelski made a motion to approve the Town Hall Facility Rental Request for the Hinsdale Fire Department for The Children's Christmas Party to be held on December 5, 2016, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Nebelski made a motion to approve the open container permit for Lois Dunham for a Wedding Rehearsal Cookout to be held on September 19, 2015 at Heritage Park, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Nebelski made a motion to approve the open container permit for Ellen Gero for an Anniversary Party on August 27th to be held at the Community Center on August 27, 2016, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Nebelski made a motion to approve the NH Public Works Mutual Aid Program Agreement, second by Diorio. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Rideout made a motion to approve the appointment papers for Mary McAlister as Deputy Town Clerk, second by Diorio. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Rideout made a motion to approve the abatement for Beverly Bernier in the amount of \$42.16 for the 4th quarter 2015 water bill, second by Diorio. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Rideout made a motion to approve the abatement for 571 Realty Trust, 727 Plain Rd., in the amount of \$117.75 plus interest for the 4th quarter of 2015 water, second by Diorio. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Rideout made a motion to approve the abatement for Robert Butler, 30 Indian Acres in the amount of \$53.42 for the 4th quarter 2015 water and \$80.26 for the 4th quarter 2015 sewer, second by Diorio. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Rideout made a motion to approve the abatement for One Mission Society, 50 Main St., in the amount of \$604.93 for the 4th quarter 2015 water and \$1,276.19 for the 4th quarter 2015 sewer, second by Diorio. Motion passes unanimously. A supplemental bill will be issued.

School Board Member, James O'Malley reported to the board that Supt. Wayne Woolridge is doing well and he has spoken with the Town Clerk about doing a collaborative run election with the elementary school regarding dog license. James will get a letter to the board.

Joe Conroy spoke to the board regarding metal garages and gave TA Collins a copy of the brochure. He stated that the town could get a three bay garage for around \$24,000 and all they would need to do is the wiring and slab.

Tax Collector, James MacDonell spoke to the board regarding the Mitchell property on Chesterfield Rd. Selectman Nebelski made a motion for the tax collector to send the 30 day notice to Terri Mitchell, second by Diorio. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Rideout discussed the Post Office celebration to take place in August.

Selectman Diorio discussed the presentation given by Joe Boggio on multi-age looping.
