

The Selectmen Meeting Minutes
Monday, March 23, 2015

Present: Chairman Darcy; Selectmen Diorio; Gallagher; Nebelski; Rideout and TA Collins.

6:00 p.m. Chairman Darcy called the meeting to order.

Selectman Nebelski made a motion to approve the manifests of March 23, 2015, second by Diorio. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to approve the public minutes of March 16, 2015, second by Rideout. The vote is as follows: Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Nebelski made a motion to approve the appointment papers Zoning Board Members – John Smith & James MacDonell; and Planning Board Member – Roberta Cook and Morris Klein, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Nebelski made a motion to approve an open container permit for The Class of 2000 reunion to take place at Heritage Park on August 16, 2015, second by Gallagher. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to sign a letter to the Division of Motor Vehicles to inform DMV that Judith Moreau has been elected to the position of Town Clerk and will be the Municipal Registration Agent for the Town, second by Diorio. Motion passes unanimously.

Andrew Madison from USDA will be attending the Selectmen's Meeting of April 6th to discuss the water plan.

Selectman Nebelski pointed out he has some problems with the small town garbage bags, one side was not sealed. TA Collins will bring the matter to the attention of Hwy Supt. Podlenski.

Selectman Nebelski pointed out the Community Center needs a snow belt and some shingle replacement. TA Collins will bring the matter to Karen Johnson's attention.

Selectman Nebelski noted the school buses seem to drive too fast especially in the 20 mile an hour zone for the schools.

The Community Ctr/Recreation Committee will be meeting this Thursday at the Community Center.

TA Collins reminded everyone that the Keene Delegation meeting scheduled is scheduled for March 30th. If anyone needs a ride, she will meet them in the parking lot outside the old Town Hall at 5:45 p.m.

Selectman Darcy would like the Selectmen to think about goals for the coming year and bring them to the next scheduled meeting of April 6th.

TA Collins will have the MRI books ready for the Selectmen to pick up later this week. She will bring books to the next scheduled meeting which have not been picked up.

Selectman Darcy informed TA Collins that the Library would like to cut the custodian hours from 3 to 2 hours per week in the next budget cycle.

TA Collins informed the Board the deadline has passed for the owner to come into compliance with 45 Canal St. The Town attorney is working on the next steps for the town to follow in order to fill the basement hole.

Megan Santor approached the board regarding holding an Easter Egg hunt at Heritage Park on April 11th. She asked if the town could reimburse her for purchases made for the Easter Egg hunt. Selectman Nebelski made a motion to approve up to \$200 for expenses to come from the Community Ctr. Program Budget line item, second by Diorio, motion passes unanimously.
