

The Selectmen Meeting Minutes
Monday, August 24, 2015

Present: Chairman Darcy; Selectmen Diorio; Gallagher; Nebelski; Rideout and TA Collins.

6:00 p.m. Chairman Darcy called the meeting to order.

Selectman Diorio made a motion to approve the public & non-public minutes of August 10th & 12th, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Diorio made a motion to approve the manifest of August 17th & 24th, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

6:20 p.m. Selectman Nebelski made a motion to enter into a non-public session under RSA 91:A-3, II, a. personnel, second by Diorio. The vote is as follows: Darcy – I; Diorio – I; Gallagher – I; Nebelski – I; Rideout – I. Motion passes unanimously.

6:37 p.m. Regular meeting reconvened.

Selectman Nebelski made a motion to seal the minutes, second by Rideout. The vote is as follows: Darcy – I; Diorio – I; Gallagher – I; Nebelski – I; Rideout – I. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to approve the open container permit for Janelle Dora for the Community Center on September 12th, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to table the request from John McCarthy for a water abatement until further information can be obtained through Dennis Nadeau, Water Supt., second by Nebelski. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Nebelski made a motion to deny the request to reduce the Five Year Permit Fee for Stearns and Raceway Park from \$1,500 each to \$1,500 for both, second by Rideout. Discussion: The Selectmen indicated that the two parks can be merged under one name. Since they are two separate parks, they should be billed accordingly. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Rideout made a motion to approve a 2.2% increase for 2016 – 2017 in wages, second by Diorio. Discussion: The Selectmen will have a workshop on September 14th to discuss allocation of merit increases for each department. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Diorio made a motion to approve the abatement for the Hogenmiller's, 218 Northfield Rd. in the amount of \$537.68 plus interest for the year 2013 & \$542.46 plus interest for the year 2014, second by Nebelski. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Gallagher made a motion to approve the timber tax levy for Diane Pringle, 257 Oxbow Rod in the amount of \$525.74, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

The Board of Selectmen reviewed the Real Estate Tax Lien List.

Selectman Rideout made a motion to donate \$75.00 to the Hinsdale Historical Society in memory of Philip Howe, second by Gallagher. Motion passes unanimously.

TA Collins informed the Board that the auditors will be arriving on September 23rd.

TA Collins informed the Board that Donahue, Tucker, & Ciandella will be accepting service for paperwork filed with the courts with the Northern New England Abatement Case.

Selectmen Rideout:

- The Field Building has water issues. Supt. Podlenski is looking at the problem and will be making suggestions.

Selectman Diorio:

- Complimented on the Staff Meeting Minutes;
- Concern with the application posted on line for Prentiss Taylor Field – indicates no alcohol usage. Discussion regarding permit took place;
- Cosmetic work was performed on the SAU; the roof has been done; the district will be turning in approximately \$652,000 to the town of unused funds.

Selectman Nebelski:

- Hwy. Dept. needs to be more cautious with their roadside mowing. A neighbor had their lilac bushes cut down. TA Collins will bring it to the attention of Hwy. Supt. Podlenski;
- Selectmen Nebelski will contact the state regarding the timed lights at the school.

Selectman Gallagher:

- The new recruit on the PD will be going to the academy;
- Would like to see one-way signs temporarily posted next Friday for the track meet;

Selectman Darcy:

- Read a letter regarding Comcast Franchise Renewal Agreement.

Sean Leary submitted pictures regarding the roadside mowing that took place on Highland Avenue. Collins will give the pictures to Hwy. Supt. Podlenski.
