

The Selectmen Meeting Minutes
Monday, September 21, 2015

Present: Chairman Darcy; Selectmen Diorio; Nebelski and TA Collins. Selectmen Gallagher and Rideout excused.

6:30 p.m. Chairman Darcy called the meeting to order.
