Present: Chair Thomas Woodbury, Trustee David Freitas; Selectman Wayne Gallagher; Sexton Anthony Orzino. Trustee Barbara Fostyck was excused.

6:35 pm T. Woodbury called the meeting to order at Oak Lawn Cemetery.

W. Gallagher made a motion to approve the Minutes dated June 8, 2017 of the previous meeting. Seconded by D. Freitas. The motion passed unanimously.

The overall impression was that the Cemetery looks pretty good. Some stones were recently straightened. A. Orzino said he plans to trim the low-hanging branches along the north edge, some of which are significant, soon. Regarding straightening some of the heavier stones, D. Freitas recommended calling on the Water Department and their equipment for help.

A. Orzino mentioned that he had been working alone this season until only a week ago.

There is a large tree on the western side of the Cemetery that needs attention. A. Orzino thinks Nichols Tree Care should address some large branches that overhang the Cemetery. He will call to get an assessment and estimate. Perhaps there are ants in the tree. If there are, and the tree is damaged enough, the tree will need to come down. Else the large branches need to be trimmed.

7:22 pm The meeting was adjourned to move to Hooker Cemetery.

7:32 pm The meeting was reconvened at Hooker Cemetery.

The metal cover on Col. Ebenezer Hinsdale's stone was discussed. A. Orzino will arrange to paint.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, D. Freitas made a motion to adjourn. Seconded by W. Gallagher. The motion passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:52 pm.
