

Planning Board
Town of Hinsdale, NH
Meeting April 16, 2019

Present: Chair Sean Leary, Tom Woodbury, Ann Diorio, William Hodgman and Selectman Mike Darcy. Lindsay Blake was excused. Three members of the public were present.

A.Diorio made a motion to approve the minutes dated March 19, 2019. She was seconded by Selectman Darcy. The motion passed unanimously.

Chair Leary explained that there were three voluntary applications in front of the Board. He asked each volunteer whether they had a choice of being a full member or an alternate. Beth Nadeau preferred an alternate position, Sandra Golden and Lisa Borst explained either position would be fine. Chair Leary asked if the volunteers had any questions.

Sandra asked if the board reaches out to businesses to see what they could do for them. The Board explained that no they don't because it would be a conflict of interest if that same business needed to come to the board with an application. They explained that there is a committee in town called HCIDC that works on economic development for the town.

Selectmen Darcy made a motion to accept all three volunteers as alternates. He was seconded by T. Woodbury. The motion passed unanimously. It was explained that the determination of the full board member would be made prior to next month's meeting.

Chair Leary explained that the board has been working on different projects the last few years like rezoning Rt.119 and the off-premise sign ordinance. For the next meeting he would like the board to think of a project for this year. He would also like to set up a joint meeting with HCIDC by June to pass along some ideas.

Chair Darcy made a motion to change the meeting time from 630pm to 6pm from now on. He was seconded by T. Woodbury. The motion passed unanimously. The Chair asked CDC Lynch to have the website updated with the new time.

The alternates left the meeting so the board could reach a decision.

Discussion followed.

Chair Darcy made a motion to appoint Sandra Golden to the board as a full member. He was seconded by A. Diorio. The motion passed unanimously. Chair Leary asked CDC Lynch to call the members.

With no other business, Selectman Darcy made a motion to adjourn at 7:12 pm. He was seconded by A. Diorio. The motion to adjourn was unanimous.
