

Selectmen Meeting Minutes
Monday, May 12, 2014

Present: Chairman Rideout; Selectman Darcy; Ebbighausen; Gallagher; Morel; and TA Collins.

6:00 p.m. Chairman Rideout called the meeting to order.

Selectmen reviewed the manifest.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to approve the manifest of May 12, 2014, second by Morel. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to table the meeting minutes of May 5, 2014, second by Ebbighausen. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Darcy made the motion to approve the open container permit for Brenda Ebbighausen on June 12, 2014 for the community center, second by Ebbighausen. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Darcy made the motion to approve the open container permit for Jeffrey Martin on September 27, 2014 for the community center, second by Ebbighausen. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Darcy made the motion to approve the open container permit for Samantha Papadimitrion for May 31, 2014 for the pavilion, second by Ebbighausen. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to hire Matthew Faulkner to work as a groundskeeper, second by Ebbighausen. The vote is as follows: Darcy – I; Ebbighausen – I; Gallagher – I; Rideout – I; Morel – abstained. Motion passes.

Darcy discussed working on the Town Clerk Compensation Plan at the next meeting and would also like to have a Non-Public under RSA 91:A-3, II, (a) personnel.

Selectman Morel spoke briefly about the Salary Study Committee. A meeting was scheduled for May 8th and was attended by three people do to conflicts.

Selectman Gallagher will be attending the conservation meeting on Wednesday night. They will be reviewing part of the master plan.

Selectman Ebbighausen asked if a program has been done regarding elderly abuse at the senior's meal. He believes it would be a great program.

Selectman Rideout spoke about contacts made to several solar farms to see if there would be an interest to locate a farm to Hinsdale.

Selectman Darcy mentioned there is a school board meeting this Wednesday.

The Town Clerk, Tammy-Jean and Chief Faulkner joined the meeting. The discussion was in regards to dog licensing and the need to follow up on forfeiture of licensing. Dog bites are on the rise and the police department needs to make sure dogs have had their rabies vaccination. The process of licensing was discussed. The Selectmen discussed a notification being placed in with Tax Bills.

Chief Faulkner discussed police officer position that is still open. He is planning to request a prior applicant to re-interview for the position.
