

Public Hearing Minutes
Monday, June 15, 2015

Present: Chairman Darcy; Selectmen Diorio; Gallagher; Nebelski; Rideout and TA Collins.

6:30 p.m. Chairman Darcy opened the public hearing and read the notice.

Chief Faulkner reviewed the changes:

Section 2. Parking Regulations, Paragraph I -U: Add to last sentence, "or if the parked vehicle represents a hazard to the motoring public and is authorized to be towed pursuant to NH RSA 262:32."

Section 2. Parking Regulations, Paragraph I - W: Add no parking on Highland Avenue, Cottage Street, Plain Road, Monument Road, Meetinghouse Road, Hancock Street, Prospect Street between Route 119 (east end), School Street in areas not specifically designated and marked for parking. Pleasant Street is to be added to no parking. No Parking – Permit Only signs will be installed. Permits can be obtained through PD.

Section 2. Parking Regulations, Paragraph I to add Section X: The two parking spaces in front of the Hinsdale Police Department shall be for the public conducting police business only at all times of the day or night.

Section 2. Parking Regulations, Paragraph III. Shall read: Between November 1st and April 1st from 11:00 P.M. to 7:00 A.M., no vehicle shall be parked on any public way within the Town. No vehicle shall be parked on any public way so that it interferes with the removal of snow from the highways and parking lots. This shall not apply to vehicles parked in designated areas except between 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. However, the Historical Society lot shall be designated as an overnight lot for emergency purposes only and vehicles must be removed by 7:00 a.m.

Rubeor Drive will be added to Section 3. Stops Signs.

Chairman Darcy asked for public comment. With no comment he closed the Traffic Ordinance part of the public hearing and opened up discussion on the smoking ban.

Paragraph 1, last sentence change "have" to "has."

7:05 p.m. Chairman Darcy asked for public comment. With no further comment, Chairman Darcy closed the public hearing.
