

Planning Board
Town of Hinsdale, NH
Meeting August 20, 2019

Present: Chair Sean Leary, Selectman Mike Darcy, Members Tom Woodbury, William Hodgman, Lindsey Blake, Sandra Golden, and Alternate Beth Nadeau. Applicant was present.

6:00 pm Chair S. Leary called the meeting to order and read the public notice for an Application for Minor Site Plan Development Review submitted by Corse Excavating LLC, tax map 30, lot 70, 205 Meetinghouse Rd., in the Rural Agricultural District, applicant proposes to extract gravel and sand.

S. Golden made a motion to accept the application. She was seconded by A. Diorio. The motion passed unanimously.

Wayne Corse explained that he submitted the site plan for 3-year approval to excavate. He reminded the Board that he was just in with NE Wetland Plants a few months ago. NE Wetland Plants found another possible site in Massachusetts but they haven't given up on Hinsdale yet. He would like to renew his permit and keep going as normal until all is figured out. He has been working on the slopes and reclamation.

Chair Leary closed the public portion of the meeting, due to a lack of public, and asked for questions from the Board.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to approve the site plan. He was seconded by W. Hodgman. The motion passed unanimously.

Board Business:

CDC Lynch explained that Walmart would like to repaint the existing parking spaces, paint the exterior of the building and add a canopy for grocery pickup. The Board explained that this could be done with a building permit and sign permit. If the signage is over the allowed signage for the parcel they will need a variance.

CDC Lynch explained that many great ideas for recreation in Hinsdale came from Picnic in the Park this past weekend. Even with the small amount of people in attendance they still had great ideas.

Chair Leary explained the film crew has been in Hinsdale. CDC Lynch will be bringing the film crew to a few businesses' tomorrow. Chair Leary asked that the Board keep in mind that they should find things that can happen in town versus why it can't, and encouraged them to be creative.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to approve the minutes dated 8-20-19. He was seconded by A. Diorio. The motion passed unanimously.

There being no further business to come before the meeting, Selectman Darcy made a motion to adjourn. He was seconded by L. Blake. The motion passed unanimously.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:20 pm.
