

MINUTES OF THE SELECTMEN'S MEETING

TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8, 2011

Present: Chairman Bellville, Selectmen Smith, Schill, Darcy & Ebbighausen, T. A. Collins was excused.

6:02 p.m. Vice Chairman Smith opened the meeting.

Selectman Schill made a motion to approve the manifest of Oct. 31st and Nov. 7th, second by Selectman Smith, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Schill made a motion to approve the minutes of the Oct. 24th meeting, second by Selectman Darcy, vote on motion as follows: Chairman Bellville, Selectmen Schill, Darcy & Ebbighausen in favor, Selectman Smith abstained, motion passes.

Selectman Schill made a motion to approve the minutes of the Oct. 27th meeting, second by Selectman Darcy, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Smith made a motion to sign the water commitment in the amount of \$153,665.99, second by Selectman Schill, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Smith made a motion to sign the sewer commitment in the amount of \$67,759.02, second by Selectman Schill, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Ebbighausen made a motion to sign the Intent to Cut for Carroll Pettengill, second by Selectman Smith, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Schill made a motion to have the chairman sign the Permit to Trap for Joseph Stevens, second by Selectman Ebbighausen, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Schill made a motion to sign the open container permit for Tracy Seidenberg at the Millstream Comm. Center on Sept. 15, 2012, second by Selectman Smith, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Smith made a motion to abate the water rent for Beverly Bernier in the amount of \$43.75, and for Jean-Pierre Fortier in the amount of \$17.40 water and \$38.86 sewer, second by Selectman Darcy, motion passed unanimously.

Board read the letter sent to William E. Watson, P. E. Administrator by Rep. William Butynski, regarding the Hinsdale Ct. River Bridge project. The board would like to schedule a meeting with all State Rep's, along with members from Southwest Regional Planning Comm. to discuss this matter further.

Selectman Darcy reported on the sign sub committee he said they are working on this matter, he further stated that the worked on the kennel ordinance and adopted it.

The conservation comm. met last week there is nothing to report.

HCIDC committee met they are working on getting new business in town.

The Hinsdale Coalition Comm. will be holding a pot luck supper on Nov. 12th at the high school.

It was noted that the board has not received the necessary paper work from them for the rental agreement.

Selectman Ebbighausen reported on a traffic problem at the scene of an accident. He said he was told there were no police officers present. Board would like Jill to discuss this matter with the chief and report back to them.

Selectman Darcy noted that the tires are still on the side of the road on the Old Brattleboro Rd.
