

MINUTES OF THE SELECTMEN'S MEETING

MONDAY, JULY 11, 2011

Present; Chairman Bellville, Selectmen Smith, Schill, Darcy, Ebbighausen & T. A. Collins.

6:00 p.m. Chairman Bellville opened the meeting.

It was noted that the name of the person requesting the water abatement was not included in the minutes of the June 27th meeting. The person was Jeff Brown.

Selectman Darcy then made a motion to accept the minutes as amended, second by Selectman Schill, vote on motion as follows: Chairman Bellville, Selectmen Schill & Darcy in favor, Selectman Smith & Ebbighausen abstained, motion passes.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to accept the minutes of the non public session of June 27th, second by Selectman Schill, vote on motion as follows; Chairman Bellville, Selectmen Schill and Darcy in favor, Selectmen Smith & Ebbighausen abstained, motion passes.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to approve the open container permit for the Hinsdale Fire Dept. to be used at Heritage Park on Aug. 20th, second by Selectman Schill, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Ebbighausen made a motion to have the chairman sign the Primex Resolution to enter into Primex Property & Liability 5% Multi Year Discount Program, second by Selectman Smith, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Smith made a motion to approve the two unit sewer hook up at the residence of Ronald Leclair 111 Brattleboro Rd., second by Selectman Schill, vote on motion as follows: Chairman Bellville, Selectman Smith, Schill & Ebbighausen in favor, Selectman Darcy abstained, motion passes.

The board agreed to keep the street lights which will be taken down by PSNH.

Chairman Bellville said that the deadline for getting information into the newsletter is July 20th, Jill will do an up date on the work being done for the new police station.

The board was informed that Canal St. LLC said they would be in this week to pay their past due tax bill in full. Selectman Ebbighausen made a motion to table this matter until July 25th, second by Selectman Smith, motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Schill reported on the following:

- 1) Enrollment in the summer program is 87 children
- 2) The crack in the pool has been taken care of.
- 3) Said there is a question as to fee at the pool for Day Care Centers. He stated the comm. would like the board to make a decision as to whether it should be limited to five children. There is a day care pass of \$65. at this time.
- 4) They have found a fence for the Prentiss Taylor field, the cost is \$700.

5) The Monadnock summer camp started at the HCC.

Chairman Bellville stated that he met with Lisa Yeaw and she is interested in doing a study on Ash trees. He said she is interested in doing some on town owned properties.

Selectman Ebbighausen brought up the following:

1) Stated that he would like to see the new proposed police station as an agenda item.

Selectman Darcy suggested that all three fireworks businesses be invited to a board meeting to discuss the ordinances.

The board has started to review the energy assessment report. Chairman Bellville would like to look into possible grant money. He also would like to have Perigrin to come in to meet with the board.

7:05 p.m. Chairman Bellville stated discussion on the sign ordinance.

Selectman Smith recommended creating a sign ordinance which would be reasonable and fair to all business owners.

It was recommended a sub committee be set up to work on the ordinances. The sub committee will be Dori Almann, Todd Page, William Nebelski, Selectmen Smith & Darcy. Rod Lawrence & Kathryn Lynch will be present as staff. The first meeting will be held on Aug. 30th.
