

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

Monday, February 12, 2018 at Town Hall

Present: Chairman Diorio, Selectmen Darcy, McCosker, Gallagher and Rideout; and T.A. Collins and Kim Worden.

6:00 p.m. Chairman Diorio called the meeting to order.

Selectman Gallagher made a **motion** to approve the manifests of 2/12/18, and the minutes and non-public minutes of 2/5/18, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

NEW BUSINESS:

Selectman Darcy made a **motion** to approve and sign the Permanent Application for Property Tax Credit/Exemptions for #02122018 (Veterans Exemption), second by McCosker. Motion passes unanimously.

T.A. REPORTS/REQUESTS:

T.A. Collins presented five copies of the Warrant for Selectmen signatures.

She had a draft of *From the Desk of the Selectmen* for the Annual Report and discussed additions to be made. She will get final draft out to all.

Next presented and discussed was the proposed *Town of Hinsdale Fees Charged and Public Hearing Notices Fees Charged* sheet with two proposed increases under the *Public Hearing Notices Fees Charged* section: Legal Ad in a newspaper increasing to \$85.00 and Notification Letters increasing to \$8.00. It was noted that these two proposed increases are due to rate increases and that we have not received enough to cover these expenses in the past. Selectman McCosker made a **motion** to approve the Town of Hinsdale Fees Charged and Public Hearing Notices Fees Charged schedule, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Matt Palmer's 2/12 Program Director Update was copied to the Board.

Jill reported that next Monday is a holiday and there will be no meeting. Rick and Jill are working on the Town Report and expect it will go to the printer on Friday.

BOARD COMMENTS:
