

*Selectmen's Meeting Minutes*

Monday, September 23, 2019 at Community Center

Present: Chairman Mike Darcy, Selectman Steve Diorio, Selectman Mike Carrier and Selectman Megan Kondrat; T.A. Jill Collins and Kim Worden. Selectman Bernie Rideout was excused.

6:00 p.m. Chairman Darcy called the meeting to order.

Selectman Diorio made a **motion** to approve the manifests of September 16, 2019 and September 23, 2019 and the minutes of September 9, 2019 and minutes of September 16, 2019 (public and non-public), second by Carrier. The vote is as follows: Darcy-I; Diorio-I; Carrier-I and Kondrat-I; Motion passes unanimously.

*T.A. Reports/Requests:*

T.A. Collins had a Master Equipment Lease-Purchase Agreement, which was approved at Town Meeting, for the Chair to sign. Selectman Diorio made a **motion** for the Chair to sign/approve the Lease-Purchase Agreement, second by Carrier. Motion passes unanimously.

T.A. Collins also indicated that she had a title to be signed re: the 2004 pickup and would like authorization for when the check is received from the auction company. Selectman Carrier made a **motion** for the Chair to sign the title for the 2004 pickup, second by Kondrat. Motion passes unanimously.

T.A. Collins noted that next week is the public hearing for sale of town properties and Department Heads will be coming in re: evaluations. She also has a non-public for tonight under (b) hiring.

Selectman Kondrat noted that she had a library meeting and that the new hours for the library are not on the website. She will get those to Jill for inclusion on the site.

Chair Darcy had a Planning Board Meeting. He gave an update on the marketing video and indicated that it is going well, there will be more steps coming up, and will be further conversation on how and where to put information on the website.

T.A. Collins asked Sean Leary how *Outdoor Hinsdale* went. Sean noted that he was not present but said the trips were full, there were many really nice pictures online, positive comments, and Kathryn did a really nice job.

The Tax Collector noted that the auditors were busy today at Town Hall.

Frank Podlenski, Highway Superintendent was present to discuss parking spaces on Main Street. Frank indicated that he needed to paint parking spaces downtown and wanted to see if the Board had any concerns or complaints as to the way it was.

Jill indicated that the State wants nothing within 20 feet of the crosswalks.

Frank noted that they will lose one parking spot in front of Town Hall (going from three down to two spaces). There will continue to be one less in front of the laundromat. There was discussion of spaces and concerns in front of the Community Center. It was agreed upon that Frank would eliminate the parking space on the left coming out of the Community Center.

T.A. Collins spoke of the engineer's ideas on crosswalks, the lack of communication with the State, resulting in the State putting all crosswalks back where they originally were.
