

Selectmen Meeting Minutes
Wednesday, December 16, 2020

Present: Chairman Steve Diorio; Selectmen Mike Carrier; Richard Johnson; Megan Kondrat; Bernie Rideout; and TA Collins.

6:00 Call to Order

Executive Budget– Rideout made **a motion to tentatively approved** the Executive budget in the amount of \$222,087, second by Kondrat. Motion passes unanimously.

Election, Registration & Vital Statistics Budget – Rideout made **a motion to tentatively approve** the Election, Registration & Vital Statistics budget in the amount of \$346,565, second by Carrier. Motion passes unanimously.

Financial Administration - Carrier made **a motion to tentatively approve** the Financial Administration budget in the amount of \$169,516, second by Kondrat. Motion passes unanimously.

Planning & Zoning - Kondrat made **a motion to tentatively approve** the Planning & Zoning budget in the amount of \$117,979, second by Carrier. Motion passes unanimously.

General Government Buildings – Rideout made **a motion to tentatively approve** the General Government Buildings budget in the amount of \$67,922, second by Kondrat. Motion passes unanimously.

Emergency Management – Discussion on the Drill/Training Salaries line item took place. Diorio suggested the removal of \$1,000 from the drill/training line and to reduce the budget to \$10,547. Carrier made **a motion to tentatively approve** the Emergency Management budget in the amount of \$10,547 second by Kondrat. Motion passes unanimously.

Solid Waste Collection – Discussion on the Transfer Station Disposal line item. Kondrat made **a motion to tentatively approve** the Solid Waste Collection budget in the amount of \$304,750, second by Carrier. Motion passes unanimously.

Library – Discussion on the Computer Expense line item. Kondrat made **a motion to tentatively approve** the Library budget in the amount of \$53,338, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

Debt Service - Kondrat made **a motion to tentatively approve** the Debt Service budget in the amount of \$103,795, second by Carrier. Motion passes unanimously.

Fire Department - Diorio discussed the increase of 2% for the Fire Department this year and discussed the 2.5% increase for next year. He suggested the Selectmen revisit the budget to increase the budget to \$255,466. Rideout made a motion to tentatively approve the Fire Department budget in the amount of \$255,466, second by Carrier. Motion passes unanimously.

Water Department – budget revisited. Follow up on the Engineering Services. Carrier made **a motion to tentatively approve** the Water Department budget in the amount of \$540,810, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.
