

Selectmen's PUBLIC HEARING Minutes

Monday, October 1, 2018

PUBLIC HEARING:

To accept testimony regarding a proposed amendment to the Hinsdale Sewer Ordinance;

To accept testimony regarding a proposed amendment to the Hinsdale Water Ordinance;

To accept testimony regarding the adoption of a Right of Way Ordinance which deals with items being placed in the Town's Right of Ways;

To accept testimony regarding the proposed amendment to all Town Ordinances which codifies the ordinances with a numbering system

Present: Chairman Darcy, Selectmen Gallagher, Diorio, McCosker and Rideout; T.A. Collins and Kim P. Worden.

6:30 p.m. Chairman Darcy opened the public hearing and read the Notice of Public Hearing. James MacDonell and Matt Palmer were the only others in attendance. It was discussed and determined that there were no calls or letters received on this matter and no public comments.

T.A. Collins commented that the signature on page 40 of the Sewer Ordinance will be removed, transitioning to a single signature page for the entire Ordinance Book. The Cemetery Ordinance will also be added. Selectman Rideout asked if the free stuff was addressed and that was confirmed. Chair Darcy asked if they should come up with a better name. Discussion followed. It was suggested that they may need to change "*free stuff*" to a more professional alternative. Chair Darcy questioned the reference to "Right of Way Agent". T.A. Collins indicated it would fall to the highway agent. After adoption, the Board can designate.
