

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes
Monday, May 14, 2012

Present: Chairman Smith; Selectmen Darcy, Ebbighausen, Rideout, Schill; TA Collins

6:01 p.m. Chairman Smith called the meeting to order.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to accept the May 7, 2012 Non-Public Selectmen Meeting Minutes, second by Selectman Ebbighausen. Motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Schill made a motion to accept the manifest of May 14, 2012, second by Selectman Darcy. Motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Ebbighausen made a motion to abate the Water Abatement for Hamblin, property located on 10 Daniels Drive, property was charged after water was shut off, the amount of \$100.00, second by Selectman Rideout. Motion passed unanimously.

Selectman Schill made a motion to sign a Cemetery Deed for Pine Grove Cemetery, second by Selectman Ebbighausen.

A corrected Notice of Intent to Excavate, from Corse Excavating, was presented to the Selectmen for the signature.

Committee Reports:

Selectman Ebbighausen discussed the shifting away from Pre-School. The Kindergarten is being reorganized. The School Board is thinking about possibly hiring a part-time Music Teacher. They are reorganizing the Guidance Department, reducing department by one. They are also reviewing their policies and procedures.

Selectman Darcy discussed that the Police Department Building Team visited the Boy Scout Park and ruled this site out because of the terrain. The team toured River Street and Heritage Park. A Comment at Heritage Park was made about the length of the building at this site. There will be no conflict with the soccer field. Heritage Park will not have a garage and this could be a problem.

Selectman Rideout mention that a Community Center/Rec Center meeting has not been scheduled.

Chairman Smith discussed the Zoning Board meeting. No abutters were present at the meeting, therefore variance was granted for a shed.

TA Collins asked the Selectmen if Matt Kennedy could borrow chairs from the Town, the Selectmen had no problem.

TA Collins stated Brian Ebbighausen asked if he could borrow some tables and chairs for a graduation party, the Selectmen had no problem.

TA Collins discussed with the Selectmen scheduling conflicts with the Boy Scout Hall. The Girl Scout Troop that meets there requested some shifting of scheduling with the Zumba class, but the Zumba is committed to Tuesdays.

Selectman Ebbighausen made a motion to make a conditional off to hire Todd Faulkner for Police Chief, subject to a final agreement, Selectman Rideout second. A discussion took place. The vote was as follows: Darcy – No; Ebbighausen – I; Rideout – I; Schill – No; Smith – I. Motion passes 3 to 2.
