

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

Monday, October 17, 2016

Present: Chairman Gallagher, Selectmen Darcy, Diorio, McCosker (arriving at 6:20 p.m.), Rideout, and T.A. Collins.

6:00 Chairman Gallagher called the meeting to order.

Selectman Diorio made a motion to approve the 10/11/16 and 10/17/16 manifests and the minutes and non-public minutes of 10/3/16, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

6:01 p.m. Selectman Darcy made a motion to adjourn the meeting for legal advice, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

6:45 p.m. regular meeting reconvened.

Selectman Darcy made a motion for the Board to sign the Warrant for Elections on November 8th, second by McCosker. Motion passes unanimously.

Selectman Darcy made a motion to have the Board sign Veteran Exemption #101716-a, second by Rideout. Motion passes unanimously.

T.A. Collins discussed and gave the tentative schedule for the Town Meeting. Selectman Darcy noted that he would like to have digital capability.

The Board had discussion on Fire Department proposed increases. T.A. Collins has sent all an estimate of cost to implement the proposed increases. Selectman Darcy would like to have more discussion on this. He would also like to have pay information checked into from similar surrounding communities. T.A. Collins noted that they could increase a little at a time and work up to scored grades. Selectman Rideout has heard of some concerns re: allowing alcohol in the building and notes that some departments allow none. He also noted we want to be fair and fiscally responsible. Selectman McCosker's concerns were that there are no requirements and nothing to address certification(s).

Selectman McCosker made a motion to table this matter, second by Diorio. Motion passes unanimously.

T.A. Collins informed the Board of receipt of \$1818.49 from Standard Power. She also gave expenditure history for four years. Elections for November 8th were noted and Selectmen availabilities were discussed. Selectman Gallagher can be available all day, Selectman Rideout from 3 p.m. on, Selectman McCosker all day, Selectman Darcy after 5, and Selectman Diorio will check and let T.A. Collins know.

Selectman Rideout indicated that he received a call concerning an incident between 1st and 2nd grade soccer coaches recently. Brett handled this. One coach is no longer coaching. Sam Killelee took over coaching. The matter has been taken care of.

Selectman Diorio informed the Board of the recent public forum on the expansion of the elementary school. There was a good presentation made. He also noted that Ranger Solar is considering a piece of property that he has. He would like to be involved in discussion, however be recused from any decisions.

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Selectman Gallagher recently attended the Conservation Meeting.

Selectman McCosker noted that he could not make the 10/4 Beautification Meeting due to illness. He will attend the meeting on 11/1/16.

T.A. Collins noted the upcoming Trunk-or-Treat event to be held on 10/30/16 and also mentioned recently attending a paint night and the possibility of having this type of community event in the future.

Selectman Darcy heard from Sean Leary that the third grade kids have picked a dog tag to give to the Town Clerk. There are hopes to be able to do this again next year.
