## Hinsdale Police COVID-19 Response

- Universal precautions will be standard, and members will utilize additional precautions as recommended by the New Hampshire Division of Public Health Services (DPHS) and the U.S. Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).
- Employees will self-monitor for sickness and report if they are in any way symptomatic (fever, cough, respiratory issues, and other symptoms as prescribed by DPHS).
- Continue immediate response for life safety events. Examples include, but are not limited to domestic assault, robbery, injury collision response, missing persons, burglaries in progress, etc.
- Proactive motor vehicle enforcement is limited to instances of more serious violations observed by officers.
- Employees are encouraged to distance contact with the public, when possible, to six feet.
- The Police Department Lobby will be closed to walk-in traffic. A sign is posted for the public to report any incident/crime via telephone at the posted number.
- The Department will suspend providing voluntary public fingerprinting services until further notice.
- Officers should issue summons whenever possible depending on the type of crime.
- Hinsdale Police Department Staff **shall** wipe down their workspaces, cruiser and phones at the beginning and end of their shifts.
